Hello Spring

Spring has arrived and you know what that means....that thing they call “Spring Cleaning”! Don't worry, below you'll find a list of ways to make Spring cleaning a lot easier!

TIPS

- To get hard to reach dirt simply put a towel or rag over the end of your broom
- Use salt to clean cast iron skillets
- Use a tension rod to hang cleaning supplies in your cabinet
- Grab a Mr. Clean magic eraser—so many uses!
- Don't forget the tiny spots such as in window seals and on cabinets
- Organize your fridge using a lazy susan! Plus this makes everything more accessible.
- Fold shirts vertically to save space
- Use the “hanger trick” with all of your clothes. —turn all of your hangers around in the closet. When you wear an item turn it back the right way. After a year whatever isn't turned around must go!
- Sanitize your sponges in the microwave for 2 minutes
- Place small toys into a laundry bag and into the washing machine to clean or dishwasher
- Clean cookie sheets with baking soda and peroxide
- Clean fan blades with a pillow case
- Use this no scrub solution to clean stove burners—zip the burner in a ziplock bag with 1/4 of ammonia, leave outside overnight, open and wipe clean
- Clean a microfiber couch with rubbing alcohol

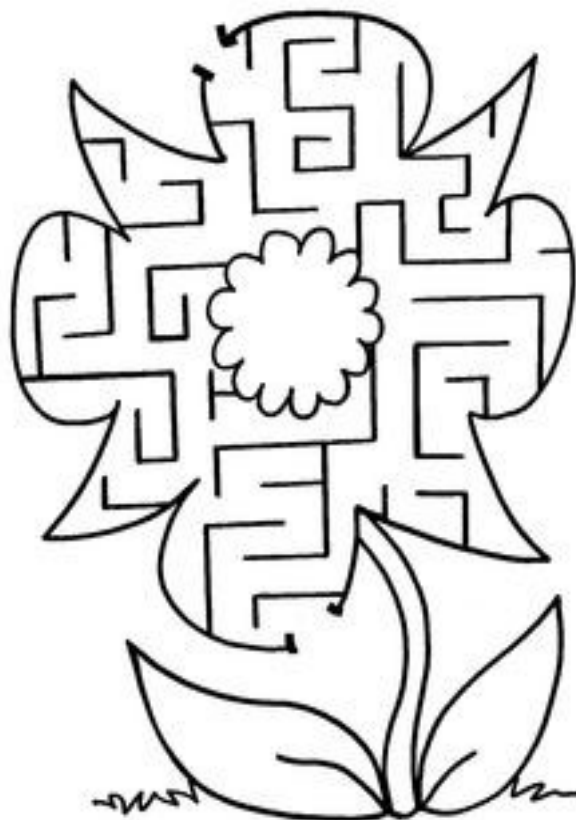

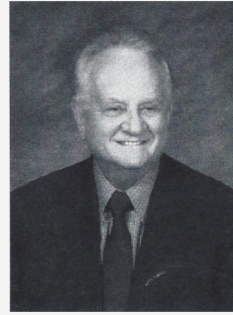
